



Blended Learning ... What it Means for Your Child(ren)

All Pupils in School

- Face to face teaching using the Pupil Led Rainbow Dreams curriculum.
- Pupils access GC, Mathletics, Giglets and Hwb from the classroom.
- Some activities completed in exercise books and distance marking approach for feedback used in KS2
- Some activities completed digitally and handed in via GC platform. Feedback given through GC and distance marking approach KS2
- Face to face lessons
- Class timetable
- Online Worship – whole school via GC

All Pupils Learning at Home (class isolation or school closure)

- At least 3 synchronous lessons weekly with a check in
- At least 5 asynchronous lessons weekly
- Pupils access GC, Mathletics, Giglets and Hwb from the home
- All activities completed digitally and handed in via GC platform. Feedback given through GC
- Work online by 8:30 am daily
- One maths, one literacy and one topic activity daily from pupils led Rainbow Dreams Curriculum
- Weekly timetable uploaded Sunday evening
- Online Worship – whole school via GC

Some Pupils Learning at Home & Some Pupils Learning at School (Child is absent from school due to a period of isolation)

- Pupil access GC, Mathletics, Giglets and Hwb from home
- All activities submitted digitally, and feedback given through GC
- Support given to pupil through GC and or telephone call
- Asynchronous lessons provided if requested
- Online worship and worship activities asynchronous
